RULES FOR WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHERS

We are happy to have you, or your company as photographers for this wedding at our church. We do have some simple, but very important rules for you to follow.

Please bear in mind that weddings at First Presbyterian Church are *worship services* where a wedding is performed. As such, photographers are to remain as unobtrusive as possible, so as not to disturb the sanctity of the ceremony, or detract from the wedding party by creating another center of attention.

We believe great pictures can be achieved with time exposures, long lenses, and camera angles from the side of the sanctuary. We know this to be true because we have seen such photographs ourselves.

Therefore we have established the following Rules for Wedding Photographers:

1. No flash bulbs or electronic flash is permitted during the service.
2. Obstructing the view from anywhere where people are sitting in the pews is not permitted.
3. Center aisle pictures may be taken provided the photographer uses a crouch position.

The balcony is available to photographers during the ceremony, and pictures may be taken anywhere on the church grounds, including the Memorial Garden, as well as in the Sanctuary after the wedding ceremony is over.

We ask for your understanding and cooperation in this matter. We reserve the right to ban those photographers who do not comply with this policy from future wedding events at this church.
