

Happiness Bullseye

OVERVIEW

Smiley-face frisbees fly through the air in this simple game of target practice.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- A large tarp
- Duct tape
- 10 frisbees (5 in one color, 5 in another color)
- Permanent markers
- 10 middle schoolers

HOW-TO

PREP

- Using duct tape, create a large bullseye in the center of the tarp.
- Draw smiley faces on the frisbees with permanent markers.
- Make a throwing line by placing a piece of duct tape on the floor.

PLAY

- 1. Create 2 teams of 5 students each and line each team up on the throwing line.
- 2. The teams will take turns throwing their smiley-face frisbees at the target.
- 3. The thrower can shoot for the center of the bullseye or knock another frisbee into or out of the circle.
- 4. Switch up the rules! The winner can be:
 - The team with a frisbee closest to the center of the bullseye.
 - The team that scores the most points within the rings of the target.
 - A winner-takes-all tournament.
