



GAME INSTRUCTIONS

Order Up!

OVERVIEW

In this fast-paced game, students in small groups will organize themselves in a variety of ways before their competitors. After a number of rounds are played, the small group that correctly orders themselves the quickest wins!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Ideas for ways students can organize themselves in their small groups (see the below examples for ideas!)
- Candy for the winners
- All of your middle schoolers and Small Group Leaders

HOW-TO

PREP

- Decide on a number of ways students will be asked to order themselves in their small groups. (Or just use the ideas below and your work is done!)

PLAY

1. Ask all of your students to get into their small groups.
2. Once they're in their groups, explain that they'll have to put themselves in order using the prompts you call out.
3. After you announce a prompt, students will race to get into the correct order.
4. Once they're in place, the Small Group Leader will raise their hand, and that group will get a point. (Only the fastest group to order themselves will get a point each round.)
5. When all of the rounds have been played, the small group with the most points wins a candy prize.

Ordering Ideas:

- Shortest to tallest
- Lightest hair color to darkest hair color
- Smallest shoe size to largest shoe size
- Birthdays starting in January and ending in December
- Darkest shirt color to the lightest shirt color
